In 2022 the BA 801 class will be offered in <i>both</i> spring and fall terms. Students enrolling in the spring 2022 term can take <i>both</i> BA 801 & BA 802. BA 802 in fall of 2022 may or may not be offered depending on the enrolment of the spring 2022 class. 2. BA 801 is scheduled on Tuesdays either 5:00 pm - 8:00 pm or 6:00 - 9:00 pm at The Harbour School (Ap Lei Chau). 3. BA 801, 802, & 803 are taught by Dr. Greenberg (face to face) 4. BA 807, 808, & 809 are taught by Dr. Hugh-Pennie (online only). 5. All students must take BA 801, 802, 803, & 807 in sequence (BCaBA & QASP-S) 6. Students with masters degrees in education or psychology can continue with BA 808 & 809. Students without masters can also take BA 808 & 809 in case they are considering upgrading their credential and/or enrolling in a masters class in the future. 7. All classes must be completed at 80% or higher grades and all supervision experience must be completed satisfactorily in order to qualify to sit for the exam for all credentials. 8. The title of BCBA, BCaBA, QBA, or QASP-S are reserved for persons who have completed all requirements set forth by each respective credentialing agency. 9. After 1 Jan 2022, students will prepare for the QABA Exam taken in Hong Kong online. TCI VCS will remain status quo during this change. The same classes in the same order for the same number of hours will continue during the transition from BACB to QABA credentials.
